PERMIT SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. An Annual Floodplain Development Permit will be applied for at the beginning of each calendar year and will expire on December 31st of the same year.
2. Only routine utility projects that do not involve any fill or permanent structures constructed in the floodplain are allowed under this Annual Floodplain Development Permit. These routine projects include the following No Impact to the Floodplain Projects:
 - Directional boring in the floodplain - the floodplain will be returned to pre-project conditions after the boring work is completed.
 - Minor Trenching (less than 18" wide) in the floodplain - the floodplain will be returned to pre-project conditions after the trenching work is completed.
 - Potholing in the floodplain – the floodplain will be returned to pre-project conditions after the potholing is completed.
3. A list of utility projects that are anticipated to be completed within the period of time covered by the annual floodplain permit shall be submitted as part of the permit application. The list shall include the project name, location, description, and construction period. A map showing each project location and extent will also be included. In the event that a project is added to the list, or a listed project changes, the project will be updated and resubmitted to SEMSWA for review prior to construction of such projects.
4. All work must also meet the requirements of the City of Centennial Land Development Code, the SEMSWA Stormwater Management Manual, as well as other applicable codes and regulations.
5. It is the responsibility of the Permittee (Utility Company Program Manager or Responsible Representative) to review and be familiar with the Floodplain Development Permit and its requirements, available online at www.semswa.org.
6. The Utility Company is held accountable for any contractor working under this annual permit and assures the contractor will meet the requirements of this permit.
7. This permit must remain active until such time as the improvements associated with this permit have received Final Close-Out from a SEMSWA inspector.
8. This permit is revocable. Failure to comply with these Terms and Conditions may result in the revocation of this permit. If the permit is revoked, a separate Floodplain Development Permit and fees for each project will be required until the end of the permit year. The application for another annual permit may not be granted.

I understand that this permit is granted under the special conditions listed above and agree to adhere to the list of Special Conditions.
