10. Activities carried out under this Annual Permit may not render ineffective, the existing erosion and or sediment control BMPs for a site that has				
other construction activities on-going. Should any BMPs for the site be rendered ineffective, the Owner will ensure that the contractor repairs or				
replaces the affected BMPs. For BMPs that include seed or sod, maintenance will be provided, including any watering necessary to insure the establishment of the sod or seed.				
11. Sediment in the flow line or tracking in the street right-of-way will be minimized, and mitigated upon discovery. Street sweeping and or other BMPs				
will be used as necessary to ensure that sediment does not enter the storm water system, during or following construction. The street may be swept				
throughout the day and at the end of each working day at minimum, but if tracking is identified, sweeping must be implemented immediately and continue until such time that tracking is no longer identified as a potential pollutant source. Enforcement may be initiated upon identification of				
tracking issues, and may escalate at SEMSWA's discretion.		-
