The undersigned hereby apply for a SEMSWA Grading, Erosion and Sediment Control (GESC) Permit for property described in this application and do certify:

1. The information provided herein is to the best of my/our knowledge is correct and is consistent with the approved GESC Plans for the site.
2. The GESC Plan for disturbed or graded area on this site has been prepared and approved in accordance with the SEMSWA GESC Manual, and the City of Centennial Drainage Criteria Manual.
3. I certify I am legally authorized to sign on behalf of and bind the above-listed entity.

This permit is granted with the explicit understanding that it is the responsibility of the owner and responsible contractor to:

1. Maintain erosion control measures in accordance with the SEMSWA-approved GESC Plan, and GESC Manual requirements.
2. Allow SEMSWA personnel unrestricted access to the site to conduct regular site inspections.
3. Revise or modify the GESC Plan and actual erosion control measures if it becomes apparent the original plan is inadequate and a SEMSWA representative directs the owner or the GESC Manager to modify the plan and the erosion control measures.
4. Immediately cease land-disturbing activities upon receipt of a written Stop Work Order from an authorized representative of SEMSWA. A Stop Work Order shall be issued and this permit revoked if the permittees are not in compliance with the City of Centennial Drainage Criteria Manual, GESC Permit, GESC Plan and Report and SEMSWA GESC Manual or the permittees fail to take corrective action within the time specified on the written notification of such non-compliance.
5. Understand that in addition to other remedies, a violation of the GESC Permit shall constitute a violation of the SEMSWA GESC Regulation and /or the City of Centennial Zoning Resolution and applicable ordinances.
6. Understand any approval obtained from SEMSWA does not absolve the need to comply with the requirements of Sections 7, 9, & 10 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, 16 U.S.C. 11531, et seq., as amended, or with any other applicable federal, state, or local laws or regulations.
7. Eliminate hazards whenever a SEMSWA representative determines that an excavation or embankment of fill on private property jeopardizes life and limb, or endangers property, or adversely affects the safety, use or stability of a public Right-of-Way or drainage channel. Failure to eliminate a designated hazard within 48 hours will result in issuance of a Stop Work Order.
