
## **SEMSWA Inspection/Escalation Enforcement Process for Contractors**



- 1. SEMSWA may elect to shorten the enforcement response depending upon the severity, magnitude, impact/or location of deficiency(s), illicit discharge or off-site release.
- 2. If an illicit discharge or off-site release is noted during the course of a follow-up inspection, the site may be issued an NOV/SWO in accordance with this process- the site may be required to submit proof that the offsite discharge(s) have been addressed.
- 3. If a deficiency is not resolved within the timeframe allotted, a Re-Inspection fee is assessed. This may include routine maintenance items that have not been resolved or any failure to implement control measures or inadequate control measures.
- 4. Compliance Assurance Enforcement Fees are beyond re-inspection fees and are intended to be significant enough to provide an incentive to focus on erosion/waste control and stabilization.

Note: Anytime significant sediment is in the street or an offsite discharge is observed, a SWO may be issued until the site becomes compliant with the GESC Plan.
